The Graffiti Removal Workshop - Professional allows for extended use with fewer return visits to vehicles for tools and chemical refills. Used for street clean-ups it contains all the tools and materials needed by operatives to remove graffiti, stickers, small fly-posters and cable ties.

The kit includes safety glasses, gloves and emergency eye wash capsules. There is space on the trolley for paper work, digital camera and other accessories, and room in the bottom tool area for a 2.5 litre paint tin allowing for re-painting of utility boxes and lamp columns when required. It also contains polycarbonate-safe graffiti wipes for bus shelters and signs. There are elasticated straps on the side of the trolley to hold waterproof clothing (not supplied). Refill packs are available for all the chemicals.

Practical Graffiti Removal
